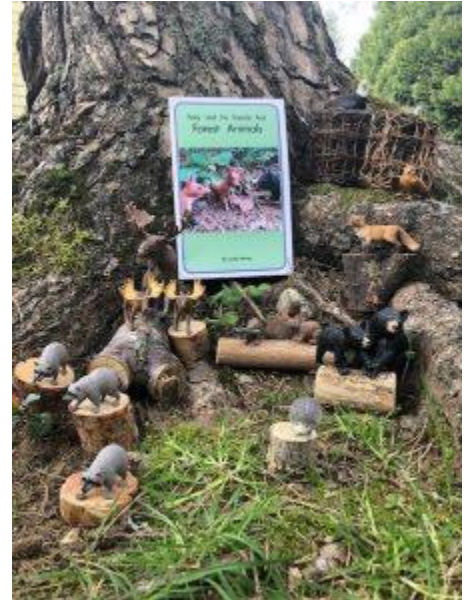

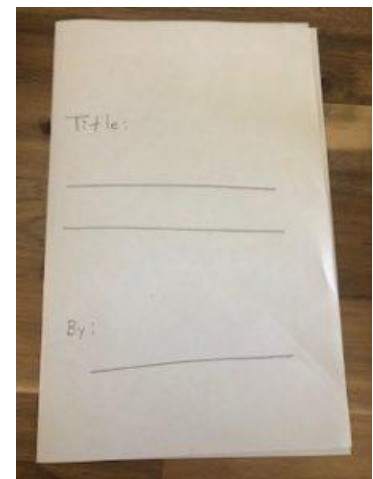
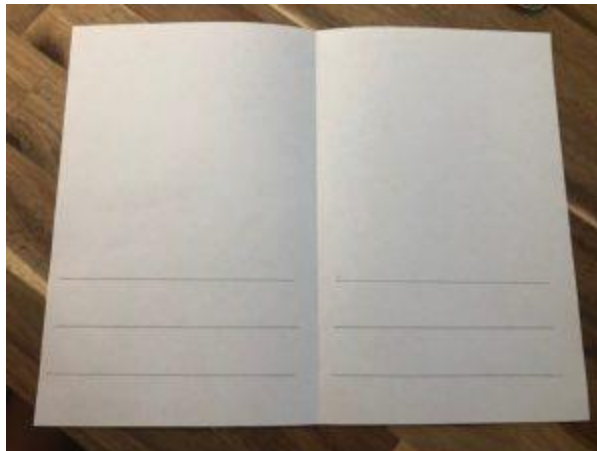

You can draw lines to help you know where to write your words.



Your page could look like this:

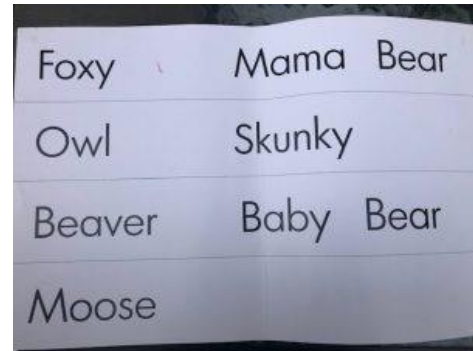
